SUBJECT: **Food, Wine & Sustainability Festival - 2013 Debrief Notes
Relating to Waste and Sustainability**

1. INTRODUCTION:

The Waste Advisory Committee has previously requested a full review on all aspects of the Food Wine & Sustainability Festival.

The information provided below is in relation to the waste aspects of the Food, Wine and Sustainability Festival. The request for a full debrief was declined as it falls outside the charter of this Committee.

2. INFORMATION:

The following information has been extracted from a debrief report written by Council's Events Team.

a) Sustainability – Edible Garden:

- Great location, high interest from festival goers, excellent display of Council's services
- Security overnight was necessary
- Similar project planned for 2014
- Quiz 'Love Food & Hate Waste' to be followed up with Emma

b) Waste

- a) Volunteers
- b) Cleansing
- c) Cooking Demonstration 'Jay Huxley'
- d) Deposit System
- e) Waste Bond

- Volunteers: Waste team really happy how it all came together in the end
- Cleansing: Issues with site cleanliness particular Beachfront (hay, rubbish)
- Stallholders to be made responsible for stall cleanliness at the event and after leaving their stalls – Issue that event staff had to clean a lot of the rubbish after the event, no cleansing staff was around
- Cooking demonstration 'Jay Huxley' did not work as set up on street level and not on risen stage (which was provided)

- Nothing could be seen from a further distance and people were not interested to come down and look at the activity
- Intimacy did not work as it is about performing to an audience
- Microphone and speakers need to be turned up as it was hard to hear what Jay was saying.
- Audience at the stage was max. 15-20 people
- Possibility for next year: Actors on stage that are more interactive, (acting sustainable living etc.)
- Deposit system requested from waste committee: (get money back \$2 for glasses), had been trialed a few years back and is not realisable as due to different factors such as: cleaning, storage, losing income, additional staff
- Waste Bond for Stallholders, can be considered however they are already paying a high amount so may not be inclined to pay – messaging of responsibilities needs to be stronger

3. RECOMMENDATION:

That the Committee considers the information provided and provide any feedback to Council staff.
