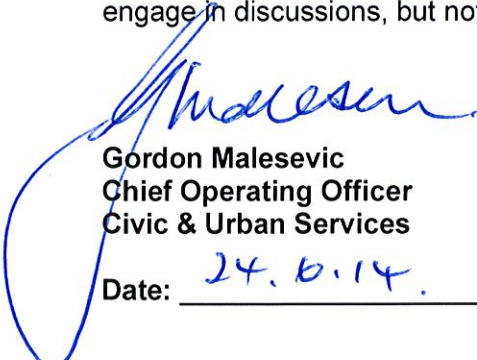

ITEM 9 GENERAL BUSINESS BROUGHT TO THE ATTENTION OF THE CHAIR PRIOR TO THE MEETING AND APPROVED FOR CONSIDERATION

Committee discussed the need for reprinting of the Manly Scenic Walkway Brochure. It was felt that this is an important resource, and due to the iconic nature of the walking track, should be represented with a brochure to assist track users.

Committee members raised the issue of bubblers along the walkway was raised, can we install more bubblers along the walkway. The manager of Parks & Reserves outlined that water sourcing along the walkway would be an issue and the cost of installation. The Parks manager advised the committee that parks section would nominate existing bubbler locations along the walkway so people are aware of where existing bubblers or water sources are located.

There is a fig tree that has been planted at the bottom of the steps below North Harbour Street it is suggested that this is located in an inappropriate position and should be relocated. The Parks manager outlined that he would look at the tree in this regard.

Recommendation:

The Committee recommend to the General Manager and Council that: The Manly Scenic Walkway brochure be reprinted for distribution.

SUBJECT: **Audit of Bubblers on Manly Scenic Walkway**

1. INTRODUCTION

The Committee has requested an audit be undertaken to identify the location of bubblers along the Manly Scenic Walkway. The aim of the request is to identify if there is sufficient facilities to cater for the users of the walkway.

2. INFORMATION

During the MSW Committee inspection of the Manly Scenic Walkway on 1st April 2014 the number and locations of bubblers was raised as a potential issue for users of the walkway. It was questioned as to whether there is sufficient facilities to adequately cater for the users of the Manly Scenic Walkway.

At the Committee meeting held on 6th May this matter was raised for further discussion. The Committee requested that an audit of bubbler locations be undertaken and reported back to the next meeting for the Committees consideration.

An audit has been undertaken and identified that there are bubblers located at;

- Manly Wharf
- Fairlight Pool
- 40 Baskets Beach
- Tania Park (Toilet block)
- Clontarf Reserve

The distance between bubblers are;

- Manly Wharf to Fairligh Pool: 950m
- Fairlight Pool to 40 Baskets Beach: 2.2km
- 40 Baskets Beach to Tania Park: 1.9km
- Tania Park to Clontarf Reserve: 2.5km

Council has received requests previously for bubblers to be installed at North Harbour Reserve, Reef Beach, and Tania Park. The request for bubbler at North Harbour Reserve will be addressed by Council as it has been detailed in the North Harbour Landscape Management Plan to be installed.

Reef Beach is not within Council's jurisdiction, and therefore will not be considered by Council. Tania Park would best be addressed through signage directing track users to the bubbler near the toilet block.
