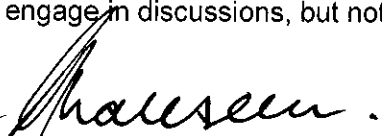

ITEM 4 Report : Manly Scenic Walkway Committee 2014 Works Program Update ACTION

Chris Kraus provided a presentation to the Committee members updating the progress and status of the Committee projects that are underway. Projects discussed included track works completion at Fisher Bay and Shelly Beach, bush regeneration works, Esplanade Park revegetation, signage audit, and Committee inspections.

An update and discussion on the Manly Scenic Walkway App project was also presented to the committee. Two options for the app were discussed which included the proposal by NPWS to facilitate the development of an audio tour app, and a Consultant has provided a proposal to develop an app modeled of a similar app Mosman Council have developed.

Committee members were asked to download both apps and review in order to participate in further discussions on preferred app for the Committee.

1. INTRODUCTION

In 2015 the Manly Scenic Walkway Committee will continue to progress the improvement of the Manly Scenic Walkway. This will be achieved by working towards the completion of uncompleted projects, identifying new projects, providing advice and recommendations towards the development of planning documents, and continuing to provide advice to Council on matters relating to the walkway.

2. INFORMATION

The table below provides an outline of projects endorsed by the Committee at the March 2014 meeting for implementation during the year subject to funding. The table includes both outstanding projects and new projects. This table was produced by both past recommendations from the Committee and from Council staff. A status report is provided below.

Bushland track upgrade (Avona Crescent entrance)	Upgrade the Avona Crescent section of track in a style similar to the work completed on the Fisher Bay track.	Not funded
Signage Review	Review track directional signage to rectify signage issues.	Implemented
Access and Landscape improvements to Beatrice Street section.	Repair stairs from Beatrice St to track, and continue the landscape improvements.	Implemented
Walking Track Audit	Undertake annual walking track audit to identify future projects and resolve issues.	Completed
