Subject: Aged Care Reforms Update

Introduction

From 1 July 2015, the Australian Government will launch the Commonwealth Home Support Programme (CHSP), transitioning four Commonwealth-funded home support programs into one program. This includes transitioning what are currently known as Home & Community Care (HACC) services into the CHSP program.

Information

Current reforms also include the expansion of the My Aged Care portal, through which all referrals to CHSP program will be streamed, including referral to newly established Regional Assessment Teams, which will undertake face-to-face assessment of clients.

The CHSP will form the entry tier of Australia's aged care system, delivering supports intended to keep frail older people living independently in their own homes in the form of either low intensity home support services delivered on a short term or ongoing basis, or higher intensity services delivered on a short term or episodic basis.

The Commonwealth recently sought submissions on the CHSP's proposed National Fees Policy, Program Manual and Good Practice Guide for Restorative Care Approaches.

The topic is of ongoing interest to the local service providers and community members on the Committee, in particular as 18.4% of Manly LGA population is aged 60 and over (2011 Census) with this number is set to grow with the ageing of the baby boomers.

Recommendation:

1. That Clare Gardiner, Home Support & Integrated Care Officer, Northside Community Forum Inc., presents to the Human Services & Social Planning Committee on 28 April 2015, on the current Aged Care Reforms.
